Market Definition – For radio, Arbitron or BIA markets are followed. One base fee is charged per market, even for stations under common ownership. As an example, Glens Falls and Albany are separate markets. Poughkeepsie and Columbia/Green Counties are different markets. For television, we will use Nielsen's DMA as the market definition

Re-inspection – in the event a station does not pass our inspection, and a re-inspection is necessary for certification, the rate will be half the base rate, plus half of the applicable amount above.
